## **Deadlines & Announcements**

**February 2** - (optional) CDIP deadline for students to submit their Motivation Statements and Collaborative Plan of Support to Graduate Studies for feedback.

**February 7** - (optional) CDIP deadline for students to submit three essays and their Student Budget Plan to Graduate Studies for feedback.

**February 12** - Last day to apply for graduation or change a graduation date and be guaranteed to have your name included in the COMMENCEMENT PROGRAM. A late fee may apply.

Last day to change a preferred name in the Student Center for use in the printed Spring 2024 commencement program. [Must have an eligible graduation date.] CENSUS (Note: Census is not associated with Add/Drop deadlines.)



**February 14** - last day to begin documented grade appeal communication with faculty for the Fall 2023 semester. If an acceptable conclusion is not reached per policy, the deadline to submit a GRADE APPEAL Form is 11:59 p.m. PST on February 29, 2024.

**February 15** - Deadline to Submit The draft CDIP application components (with the exception of the recommendation letters) to Graduate Studies for review.

February 24 - Deadline to Submit CDIP final application and all documents.

**March 1**, - Student registration to participate in the Spring 2024 Commencement ceremonies will be available.

March 10, Submissions for the Patricia O. McConkey Outstanding Graduate Student are due. These awards recognize the outstanding student graduating with a master's degree from each program. There will be multiple McConkey awards; each program may select one awardee. Students who will have completed a master's degree between May 2023 and May 2024 are eligible.

**March 11** - Last day to change registered class grade option to CREDIT/NO CREDIT. Only one optional CR/NC course can be taken per term.

March 11-15 - SPRING BREAK

March 22 - The class schedule for Fall & Summer 2024 will be available online by noon.

**March 28** - Deadline: WITHDRAW (prorated refund\*) – Last day to request permission to withdraw from the spring semester and be eligible for a prorated refund of less than \$20 per course and a \$27 administrative charge\*. Permission to withdraw and documentation of a serious & compelling reason is required. A grade of "W" will be recorded for each course. [After this date students are not eligible for a refund of fees.] See Withdrawal Process.
