## **Quick Notes**

Practice your presentation enough to ensure that you **keep to the 3 minute limit**. If your presentation is more than 3 minutes, **you will be disqualified.** 

Make sure to **practice** your presentation enough so that you do not need to refer to notes. Judges will deduct points if you appear to be reading a script.

Criteria	Description	Max. Points
Clarity	Did the speaker provide adequate background knowledge to make the talk and the importance of the project understandable?	5
Organization	Did the presentation follow a clear and logical sequence?	5
Language Matches Audience	Was the topic and significance communicated in a language appropriate to an interested, but non-specialist audience?	5
Significance	Did the presenter explain why the project mattered, addressing the impact and result of the research?	5
Delivery	How was the delivery, including pace, enthusiasm, confidence, body language, and dynamism of vocal delivery?	5
Visual	Did the slide enhance the presentation and help to emphasize the primary points of the talk? Was the slide well designed, clear, and legible and concise?	5
Engagement	To what extent did the talk speak to your intellectual curiosity? Did it make you want to learn more about the topic?	5
