Announcement Graduate Continuous Enrollment	 Reviewed the process of enrolling in the Graduate Continuous Enrollment course. Students are required to enroll for a minimum of one unit per term for at least two terms per academic year (fall, spring, summer)
Contact Melissa Tafoya/OOR/Transfer & Graduation Counselor or Terri Fisher/Graduate Studies if you have questions	until your degree requirements are completed. Master's degree students who do not maintain continuous enrollment (two terms each academic year), and who have not been granted a leave of absence are required to reapply for admission to the university and to the graduate program. If readmitted, students will be subject to any new admission or degree requirements that have been approved since the first admission to the program.
