Financial Aid

To apply for aid, a student should complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form online at fafsa.ed.gov or studentaid.ed.gov. The application opens on October 1st and the deadline to apply every year is March 2nd.

Aid is usually limited for those already holding a bachelor's degree. However, in addition to unsubsidized loans, graduate students may be eligible for other financial opportunities such as:

- Federal Work Study
- Graduate Assistantships or Teaching Associate Positions
- HSU Scholarships and Grants
- Tuition Fee Waivers

Academic Calendar

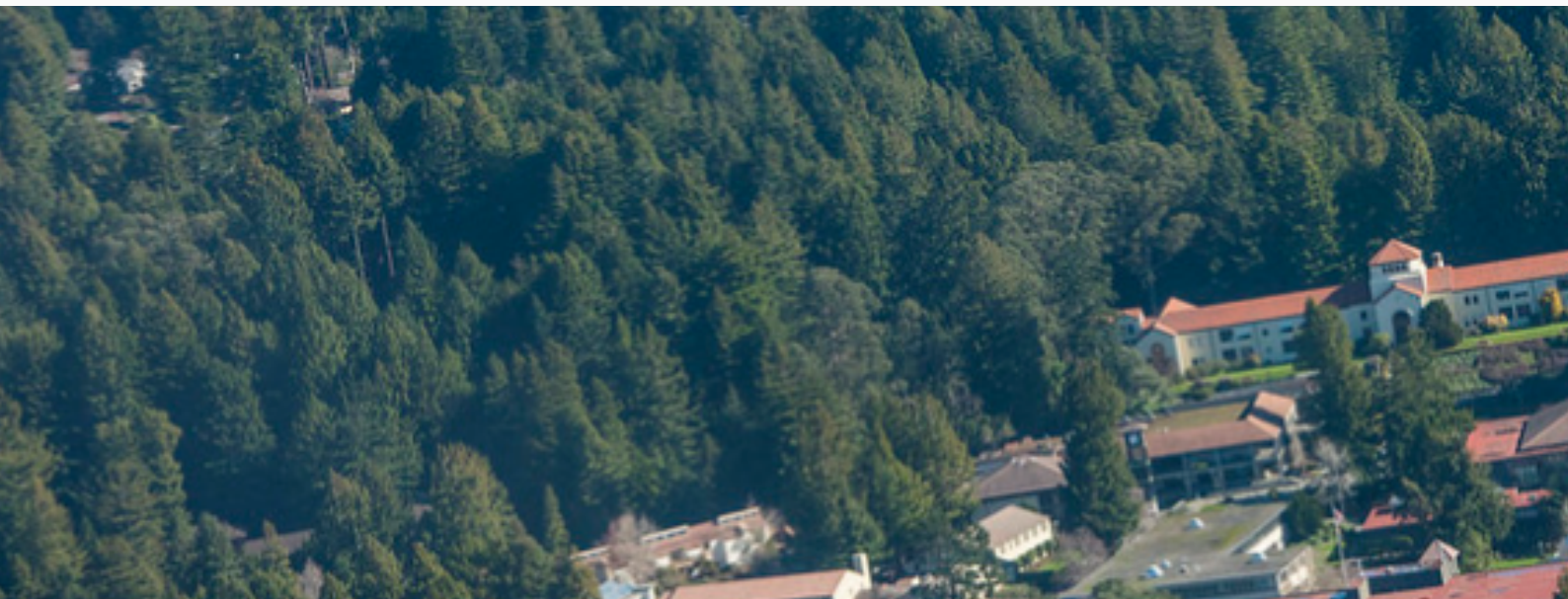

Graduate Student Forms & Policies

Graduate students taking nine or more semester units are enrolled full-time. You must maintain Good Academic Standing, which means a GPA of at least 3.0 (B) or better in all courses taken to satisfy your degree requirements.

You are required to enroll for a minimum of one unit per academic term for at least two terms per academic year until your degree requirements are completed. Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations limits the maximum time for completing a master's degree program to 7 years.



Things to do at HSU

HSU is the northernmost campus in the California State University system, located in a rural area 270 miles north of San Francisco. Our stunning natural environment is both a natural laboratory and a great place for adventure. Our “backyard” is 110 miles of coastline and 680,000 acres of state and national parks. In addition to exploring the amazing area surrounding HSU, there are plenty of things to do on campus itself.

Arts

The Center Arts box office offers information and ticket sales for many events on campus such as musical concerts, theatrical performances, dance, and special events.
